ABOUT UZBEKISTAN



Uzbekistan is a Central Asian nation and former Soviet republic. It's known for its mosques, mausoleums and other sites linked to the Silk Road, the ancient trade route between China and the Mediterranean. Samarkand, a major city on the route, contains a landmark of Islamic architecture: the Registan, a plaza bordered by 3 ornate, mosaic-covered religious schools dating to the 15th and 17th centuries.

The Republic of Uzbekistan is situated in Central Asia, and covers an area of 448.9 thousand sq. km. The length of the territory of the Republic

from west to east is 1 425 km from north to south - 930 km. The territory in the north and north-east of the Republic of Uzbekistan borders with Kazakhstan, in the east and south-east with Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan in the west with Turkmenistan, in the south with Afghanistan. The total length of the country border is 6221 km. The long border with Afghanistan is 137 km, with Kazakhstan - 2203 km, with Kyrgyzstan - 1099 km, with Tajikistan - 1161 km and Turkmenistan - 1621 km (administrative-territorial structure of the Republic of Uzbekistan).

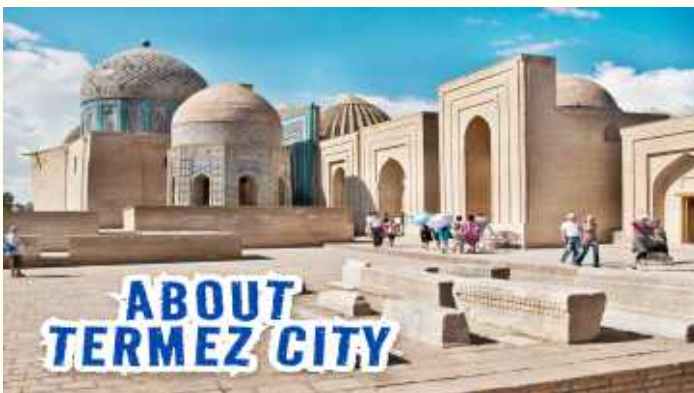

Termez is the capital of Surxondaryo Region in southern Uzbekistan. Administratively, it is a district-level city. Its population is 182,800 (2021). Termez is one of the ancient cities of Central Asia, which evolved throughout the history on different places around the modern city, reflecting multiple cultural layers depicted in remains of historical sites. The cultural heritage that was developed from the inception of the city was completely destroyed by Genghis-Khan in 1220, after the city refused to surrender peacefully. A new city was erected to the

east of the old town.

In Termez in summer, there is exceptional heat, in winter the climate is quite mild for such a latitude, but sometimes quite severe cooling and snowfalls are possible, however this is usually not for long. Flight Direct flights connect Tashkent with Termez (1h30), Saint-Petersburg and Moscow. The airport is a 15 minute taxi ride from the city centre. and it is also connected by Train and it is overnight journey between Tashkent To Termez around (15hour).

The branch has 5 undergraduate and 20 clinical residency courses in 4 faculties, and the educational process is conducted in Uzbek, Russian and English languages.

In the 2023-2024 academic years, the total number of students in Termez branch of TMA is 3,629, of which 1,515 are girls and 2,114 are boys. The number of students from India is 195. These students are studying in 1-2-3 courses. This determines the prestige of the branch in foreign higher education institutions.

Branch students regularly participate in student scientific and academic forums.

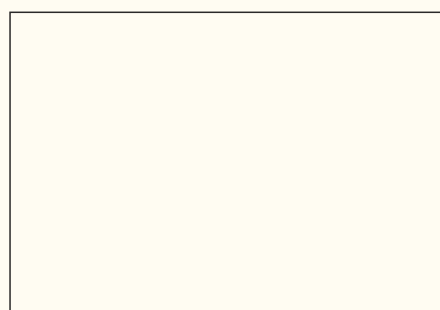
